Urge Senators to Protect Health Care for All















On Thursday, June 22, Senate Republican leaders introduced draft legislation to partially repeal and replace the Affordable Care Act. An updated version of the measure, the Better Care Reconciliation Act (BCRA), was released on Monday. A vote is expected to be held when senators return from the July 4 recess.

The BCRA would be devastating for millions of Americans. Under the Senate proposal, 22 million Americans would lose coverage, Medicaid and Medi-Cal budgets will be slashed by \$772 billion over the coming decade and individuals will see insurance premium increases by 30 percent in the next year.

California's Senators Dianne Feinstein and Kamala Harris have voiced their strong opposition to the BCRA. They are asking Californians to reach out to senators in Republican represented states who have indicated concerns about the bill.
